

How to Use the Articulation Plans

In an effort to maximize the transfer of credit, we attempt to match-up the community college associate degree with the Davenport University bachelor degree that has the “best fit”. This does not mean that you can pursue only this degree. You can choose to pursue any bachelor degree at Davenport University that you desire; however, the credits may not have the same fit with other bachelor degrees.

The Articulation Plans were specifically designed for use by counseling and advising staffs of the community colleges throughout Michigan and Northern Indiana as they work with students interested in transferring from the community college to Davenport University.

Students may use these Plans if they desire, but the Transfer Guide was designed specifically for use by students interested in transferring to Davenport University. The Transfer Guide is easier to use and less complicated. Click on the back arrow of your browser to access the Transfer Guide for the community college you attend.

HOW TO DETERMINE WHICH ARTICULATION PLAN YOU SHOULD FOLLOW

1. Click on the bookmark labeled Cover Page.
2. Scroll through the associate degree programs listed on the left hand side of the page and locate the name of the associate degree program you are pursuing at the community college.
 - a. If the associate degree you are pursuing at the community college is not on the list, please contact an admissions representative at the Davenport University location nearest you for assistance.
3. Click on the program name you are pursuing at the community college and the corresponding Davenport University Articulation Plan will appear.
4. Print two copies of the Articulation Plan - one for your records and one to give to your Davenport University admissions representative.
5. When you meet with your Davenport University admissions representative make sure to let him/her know the specific Articulation Plan you are interested in following to earn your bachelor’s degree from Davenport University.

HOW TO INTERPRET THE ARTICULATION PLANS

The Articulation Plans are composed of 8 columns of information:

1. The first three (3) columns identify Davenport University information. The first column contains the Davenport University course code, the second column contains the Davenport University course name and the third column contains the number of credits this course is worth at Davenport University.
2. The next three columns (columns four, five and six) identify the community college information. The fourth column contains the community college course code, the fifth column contains the community college course name and the sixth column contains the number of credits this course is worth at the community college. The course codes, course names and credits that appear in red identify the courses that make up the associate degree at the community college and show these courses fit into the bachelor degree at Davenport University.
3. The seventh column, labeled **3rd Year**, identifies courses that may be taken either at the community college or at Davenport University. A student may transfer up to 90 credit hours from the community college.
4. The eighth column, labeled **Davenport Credit**, identifies those courses that must be taken at Davenport University to meet program major and residency requirements in order to earn a bachelor’s degree through Davenport University.
5. The bottom of each column is totaled to identify the number of credits that will be earned by completing the associate’s degree, courses taken in the 3rd Year and courses that must be taken at Davenport University.
6. At the bottom of the Articulation Plan are two green boxes. One box identifies the total number of credits that will be taken to earn the bachelor’s degree through Davenport University, the second box identifies the total number of course that must be taken at Davenport University to earn the bachelor’s degree through Davenport University.
