In order to be granted articulated credit the student must meet the following requirements:

1. The student must earn a grade of 3.00 (on a A=4.00 scale) or higher in each course in order for credit to be articulated.
2. The student must also begin attending Davenport University within 27 months from the date of their high school graduation.
3. The instructor must sign the articulation submission form which verifies the student has completed the necessary course work to be granted the articulated credit requested.

Credits articulated will become part of the total number of credits for program completion at Davenport University and will appear on the student's Davenport University transcript by course code and credit hour. No grade will be recorded. Tuition and fees will not be charged for articulated credits. Articulated credit is not the same as dual enrollment credit.
